

HOW TO GET YOUR GO CHARGER SEMESTER PASS:

- Go to your My Charger Account
- On the left menu bar, select **Public Safety**
- Scroll to the **Directory** and then select **Parking**
- Under Welcome, click the first link called Parking Website
- Click on ChargerGo Bus Pass





When Paying For Your ChargerGO Bus Pass:

- 1. You must use a Credit Card or Debit Card.
- 2. **Use the billing address associated with the card** you are using to pay, not your new, local address.
- 3. If you use the wrong billing address, the issuance of your ChargerGO bus pass will be delayed.

YOU WILL SEE THE FARE BOX AS SOON AS YOU ENTER THE BUS FROM THE FRONT DOOR



- Insert cash here, and then
 - collect your ticket if you paid cash.
- OR swipe your ChargerGO semester pass.
- OR tap your phone pass.





THINGS TO CONSIDER:

- 1. Enter the bus from the front door on the right.
- 2. Pay before you ride the bus.
- 3. If you are using cash to purchase your ticket on the bus, carry **exact change** as no change is dispensed from the fare box! We recommend always carrying \$1 bills and quarters (\$0.25).
- 4. A monthly pass must be purchased online or on the Transit app before you ride.
- 5. Avoid playing loud music or avoid using a phone with the volume turned up to respect other passengers.
- 6. Never argue with a bus driver.
- 7. We recommend students use the bus with a friend or in groups whenever possible.
- 8. For passenger safety, all buses are numbered and have security cameras inside.
